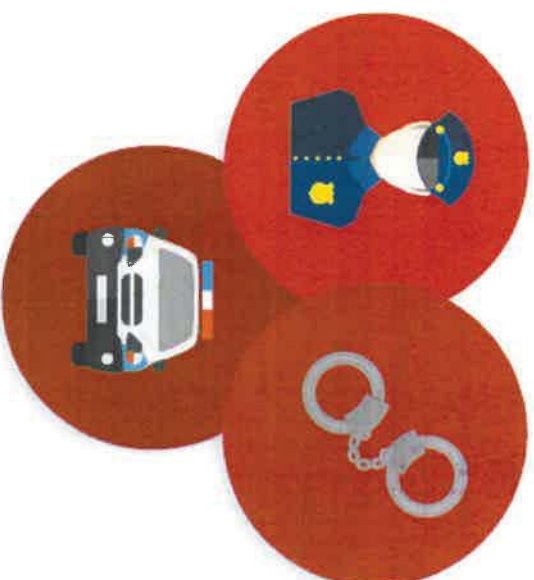


# If the authorities detain you, do not resist

Remember:

- Keep calm.
- Follow the instructions of the officer.
- Act with respect.
- Never hit or harm the officer.
- Do not give false information.
- Do not try to bribe the officer.
- Do not talk about your immigration status with the officer.



If you resist a detention or arrest, you could be submitted by force causing you injuries and even **adding criminal charges** against you. If you are not a U.S. citizen, this situation could cause you deportation.

# If the authorities detain you, do not resist

Remember, you have the right to:

- Remain **silent**.



- Request a **lawyer**.



- Express that **you do not consent** to a search of your person, house or belongings.



- **Make a call** within the first few hours of being detained.



- Contact your **Consulate**.



- **Not sign** any documents you do not understand, especially if it is in English, without the advice of your lawyer or your Consulate.

# What happens if you are stopped for a traffic violation?

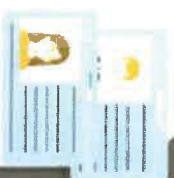
1. Stay calm and follow the officer's instructions.



3. Do not exit the vehicle unless the officer tells you to.



4. Show your driver's licence or a photo ID and car insurance requests them.



5. If you do not speak English, let the police officer know.



2. Turn off the radio, put your hands on the steering wheel, and do not make any movements that might seem suspicious.
